

Libertas Prep Science & Bible Classes 2021-2022

Open to all independent study students

Libertas Preparatory School at Trinity Classical Academy is thrilled to offer two outstanding courses taught by Oxford graduate Dr. Mark Phillips, Chair of Theology and Science at Trinity Classical Academy. Both classes will be held on the Trinity campus and will be taught from a Biblical worldview perspective. The Biology course is a solid high school level science course that includes labs. It provides a great opportunity for those students who plan to pursue further higher-level science courses, as well as, students coming in at the introductory level who desire foundational science knowledge and high school course credit. Dr. Phillips is also excited to share his passion for God's word as he teaches biblical apologetics to students in grades 7 - 12. Both courses include the Christian foundation of modern science and evidence for the Creator of the Bible.

Biology: Wednesdays 2:05pm - 3:05pm Room 104 (Grades 9-12)

This course covers all topics outlined in the California Standards for secondary level Biology instruction. It is designed to prepare students for further studies in Biology at the collegiate level. Focus will be on evidence for a Creator/Designer of the universe, and for a Programmer/Desiger/Creator of life systems, especially in molecular biology. Topics include: biochemistry, molecular biology (especially protein synthesis, photosynthesis and cell respiration, genetics, Darwinian/neo-Darwinian theories and their problems, and biological origins, including synthetic biology and challenges to RNA World Theory. Labs relevent to material will be included. Includes all class texts.

Bible: Fridays 2:05pm - 3:05pm Room 104 (Grades 7-12)

Bible will be taught by Oxford graduate Dr. Mark Phillips, Chairman of Theology and Science at Trinity. We will learn biblical apologetics: why the Bible is true, the reliability of its veracity, the evidence that it is the Word of God. We will also go through John, referring to it as an example of the reliability of the Gospels. There will also be some references to the synoptic gospels, Matthew, Mark, and Luke. By the end of the year, your student will have full confidence that the Word of God that you read today is the true testimony of the Creator, God, Lord, and Savior. We will also read through Dr. Phillips' autobiographical account of his journey to faith in Christ through science and the deception of New Age philosophy, the postmodern spirituality dominating our culture right now. *\$15 book printing cost not included.
